Pune: Director of National Centre for Cell Sciences (NCCS) Shekhar Mande conducted a lecture for school students about the molecules in living systems, recently.

He was addressing school students on 'From molecules to life'. He explained to the students the progress of life from a molecular stage to a living being.

This was as part of the Exciting Science Group's (ESG) Popular Science Talks. Mande explained the complexities of living systems that act as distinguishing factors from the non-living which he explained to be caused because of a small subset of building blocks.

He elaborated on some of these building blocks that combine together to yield the complex traits, including growth, behaviour and emotions in living beings.
