Facts about the Human Brain


Weight: 1.4 kg

No. of Neurons: 100 billion = 10^{11} = 100,000,000,000


No. of connections made by each neuron: 1000 – 10,000


Total length of neurons: 4.8 x 10⁶ km

Speed of information transfer: 120 m/s




A simple Neuronal Circuit






One to One mapping of Retina onto higher centre





Wrong mapping of retina on higher centre




Anton Räderscheidt (1892 – 1970)

Suffered from a cerebral stroke


Continued painting as he recovered

Late 1967 → Early 1968


